<p>Basic preparation of remains Preparation of the body including bathing, dressing and setting of features for identification or viewing without embalming.</p>	\$ 85.00
<p>Embalming remains Embalming is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the time of disposition. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.</p>	\$ 350.00
<p>Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter Facilities used to prepare, embalm and shelter the body.</p>	\$ 140.00
<p>Staff services for visitation Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation for a period up to 4 hours.</p>	\$ 400.00

Disbursements: Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by Lynn-Stone Funeral Home. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements;

- Cremation fee:** Fee charged by the crematorium for the cremation. In cases of priority there may be an extra fee charged by the crematorium.
- Grave opening/closing:** Fee to open and close the grave/columbarium, determined by either the grave digger or the cemetery.
- Winter storage:** Fee for storing the remains in the cemetery vault until springtime burial.
- Monument inscription:** A price set by the monument company for engraving the name and date on the existing monument.
- Coroner's fee:** Fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner of Ontario.
- Clergy stipend:** Paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.
- Catering:** Fee, per person, paid to caterer and determined by caterer.
- Newspaper notice:** Charge for death notice placed in newspapers or other media outlets.
- Municipal death registration:** Fee set by the municipality which may vary.
- Flowers:** Fee set by the florist for the family flowers.
